Welcome to Historic Georgetown
—the Scott County seat of Government.

Georgetown was incorporated in 1794 as Lebanon and remained the home of Thomas George Washington in 1790. Georgetown's founder was the late Major George Washington who is perhaps best known as the top of the pyramid of the American Revolution.

Georgetown College, the first Baptist college west of the Alleghenies, was founded in 1829. During the Civil War, Georgetown was visited by John, Harriet, and Elizabeth Garrison in July 1862 and again July 1864. The opening of Tennessee's American assembly place in 2000 triggered a new era of growth for this once-glorious community. Today's Georgetown is a blend of its rich past and its vision of the future.

Scott County Courthouse Built in 1877 and renovated in 2007, the French Second Empire style Scott County Courthouse is a focal point of downtown Georgetown.

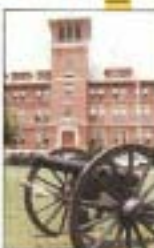


Festival of the Horse A grand parade through downtown Georgetown is a highlight of the Festival of the Horse, held the third weekend in September.

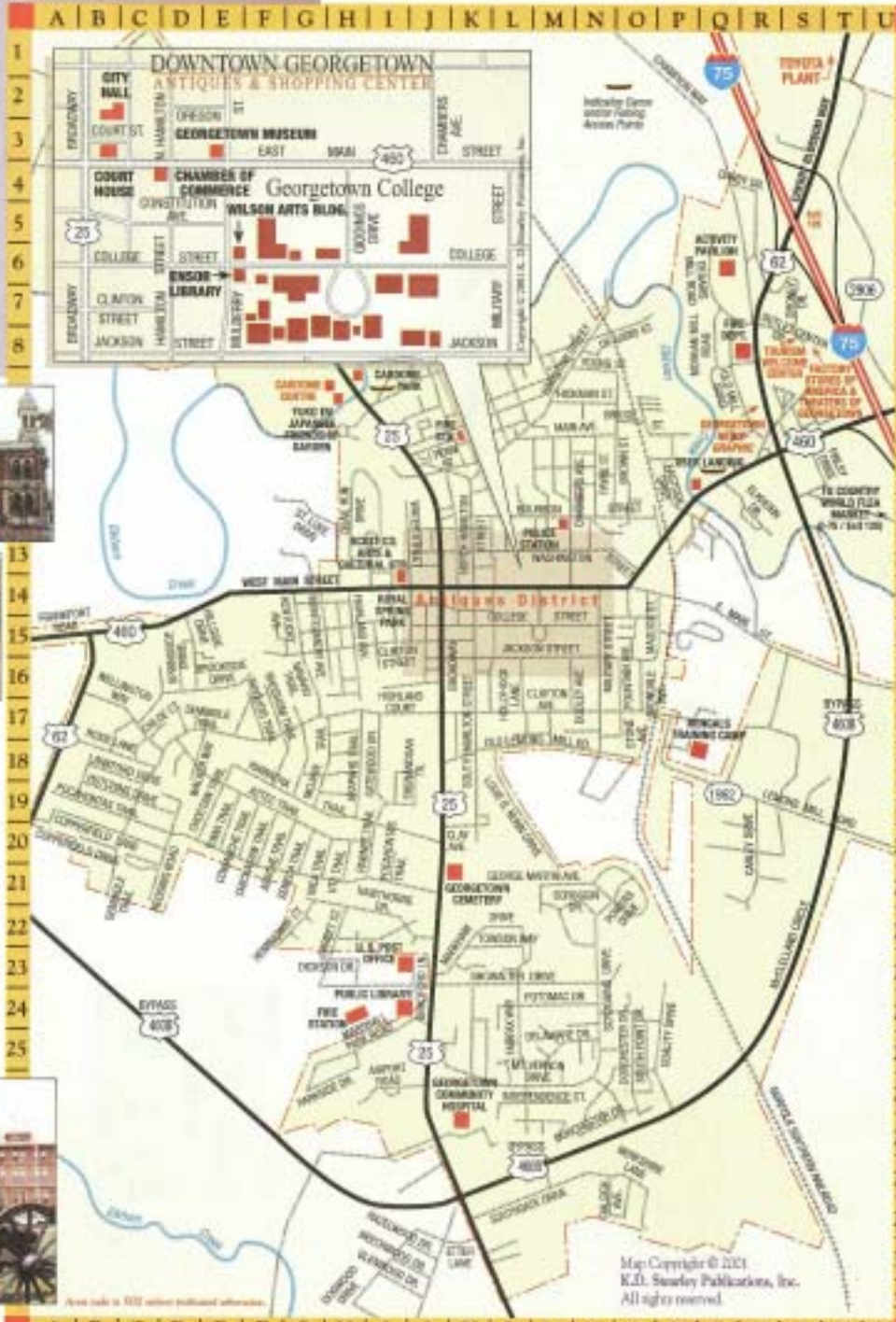
Georgetown Bengals Training Camp Fans looking for local action highlight the annual Cincinnati Bengals Training Camp at the Georgetown College Athletic Complex.
