Invitational Education® (IE) is a very effective theory and practice for the development of positive school environments to unleash students' potential. Through IE, positive school climate is intentionally developed which is well based on the assumptions of trust, respect, optimism, and care. Research also has suggested that Invitational Education Theory is a validated model to help students achieve academic and holistic success (Purkey & Novak, 2009).

IE has spread much more quickly, with a growing number of schools in Hong Kong and the Mainland of China in recent decades. With the vision of Dr. Jim O'Connor (Ph.D.), Dean of the College of Education and Health Sciences & Professor in the Touro University California realized that teacher preparation initiatives focused on invitational education has largely been demanded in Asia especially in HK. They have created a Graduate Certificate in Invitation Education that will be extended into a full Master of Education in Invitational Education starting in Jan 2018.
